

Tuition-

- Our fall/spring season is 36 weeks long. Tuition is paid in 6 equal scheduled installments over the season. A \$ 15 (max \$30/family) per year dancer registration fee is due at time of enroll, along with 1st six week tuition payment.
- All payments will be applied to tuition first.
- Liberty Dance Center reserves right to charge the most recently used credit card on file to accounts not paid in full the Sunday after tuition due week.
- Students may not participate in recital until all tuition and fees are received / cleared.
- A \$ 10 per per week, late fee will be added to payments received after the due date.
- \$30 fee apply on all returned checks.
- Parents will be required to read and accept our on-line Parent Agreement/Waiver form before child begins classes.

Missed Class/Withdrawal Policy-

- There are **NO refunds** for missed classes or withdrawing from classes.
- In the case of withdrawal, unused paid tuition will remain as credit for up to two years from the date of withdrawal for future tuition use. This credit is non-transferable.
- Missed classes may be made up within 60 days in a class level equal to or below the dancer's assigned grouping. No class make-ups are allowed once recital choreography has been started.

Recital-

- Annual recitals are usually held the weekend after Memorial Day at the Hamilton Fine Arts Center which is located in Sussex, WI.
- Detailed information on recital will be made available starting in December.
- Key dates- Photo Days; May 22-24th, Dress Rehearsals: May 25 & 30th. Recital: June 2,3.

Costumes-

- All classes will have a recital costume.
- Costumes **will not** be ordered until full payment is received by studio which is due in December.
- Costumes will be distributed to students in April. Account needs to be paid in full in order to receive your costume.

Inclement Weather Policy-

- Closings will be announced on our website, our studio Facebook page and TMJ4 television/radio.
- Please make up cancelled classes at your convenience within 30 days.
- Safety of our students and staff is on #1 priority when determining cancellations.
