HAIR: needs to be pulled back, away from the face and secured (in ponytail or ballet bun)

SHOES: wear proper dance shoes for the style you are taking! See next page for photos.

ATTIRE:

Girls: Tight fitting clothing (ex: leggings, leotards, tights, tight tank top, dance shorts).

***No sports bras without a shirt over please.*

Boys: Wear athletic clothes that you can move in!

***Hip Hop class can wear baggier clothing.*

Please NO: jeans, baggy sweatshirts/tees... we need to be able to see your lines!
